- **AS:** Ambulation Score
- **BMRC Rating Scale:** British Medical Research Council Rating Scale
- **cc:** cum correctione. With Visual Correction

- **EDSS:** Expanded Disability Status Scale
- **EOM:** Extraocular Movement Impairment
- **eCOA:** Electronic Clinical Outcome Assessment
- **FS:** Functional System
- **FSS:** Functional System Score
- **Grade** means a possible level of severity of patient symptoms
- **IM:** Investigator Meeting
- **LE:** Lower Extremities (Limbs)
- **MS:** Multiple Sclerosis
- **Neurostatus-EDSS:** Neurostatus Expanded Disability Status Scale
- **Neurostatus-eEDSS:** Neurostatus electronic Expanded Disability Status Scale
- **OD:** oculus dexter. Right eye
- **OS:** oculus sinister. Left eye
- **OMP:** Overall Motor Performance
- **PRO:** Patient Reported Outcome
- **sc:** sine correctione. Without Visual Correction
- **Scoring Sheet:** Neurostatus-EDSS Scoring Sheet Version 04/10.2
- **Scoring Table:** Neurostatus-EDSS Scoring Table Version 04/10.3
- **Sign** means an objective observation that can be detected or perceived by a healthcare professional
- **Subscore** means the score given to each Neurostatus-EDSS examination based on the rater's assessment of the severity of the patient's symptoms
- **Symptom** a subjective experience that is felt or noticed by the patient
- **UE:** Upper Extremities (Limbs)
